In 2025, we had a team of students from Edson Yellowhead Christian School join us in Romania in March for a 2 week construction time working on the balcony of the main lodge. It was "tons" of work in concrete and brick laying and the youth did a great job. Our family also was back in Romania in July to see the impact of the camp on the youth. It was a tremendous time witnessing the work of so many volunteers and donors over the years being used in a great way. It really affirmed that this is a ministry that is being used mightily to impact the culture of the Transylvania area.
